RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working on production preparation
 - Rehearsing for the production as cast and/or crew
 - Being assigned to a crew and working in that department (costumes, makeup, stage construction, marketing and promotions, graphic design, stage lighting, office assistant, film and media assistant, etc.)
- *An Intern may request to work in a certain department of their interest, but the assignment of each Intern will be made depending on the overall needs of the ministry at that time.
- Cleaning before or after a production
- Performing in plays or concerts in the theatre
- Maintenance, yardwork, and meal clean up
- Helping and assisting with the projects outside of the Theatre in which the Academy is involved
 - Bible Club
 - Assisting local churches with their cantatas (Christmas, Easter, etc.)
- Other responsibilities may arise with the unique aspects of our performing arts ministry, and each Intern should be ready to help in whatever way is needed.

SCHEDULE

- Monday OFF (With the exception for production times when extra rehearsal or preparation is needed)
- Tuesday-Friday
 - Chapel each morning where students will be taught Biblical truth and doctrine.
 - Interns will attend the regular Bible class and choir rehearsal each week with the Conservatory students.
 - Each month, interns will be assigned to an area of interest (either to a department or specific staff member) for a block of time.
 - Outside of the scheduled time that they will be concentrating on their area of interests, interns will be assigned to help in whatever department they are needed depending on the needs of the ministry.

PROGRAM COMPLETION

At the conclusion of the GAP year, each Intern will receive a Certificate of Completion.

**The Interns will be encouraged to keep a personal transcript of their hours spent working and ministering. They will be able to submit this record for an official transcript that will have a list of transferable credits.*
